PREVIOUS WEEK INFO

POTTY TIME!

As the littles are getting bigger, we have potty trained littles, some in process, some starting, and some thinking about when and how to begin, WOW!

I do have a "Potty Training" section the Parent Handbook/Contracts, but wanted to quick bullet point some things here for you as I help support you in your potty training at home.

- Kiddos might be ready as early as two, or as late as even 4 or 5 (it is okay either way, they will get there!)
- Should be able to pull up and down pants with little to no help, so no crazy contraptions trapping them in their clothes, haha. I will obviously help, but the easier on us, the better... it is just me here -)
- Should be able to fully communicate to you that they have to "go" & can "hold it" until they are at the potty
- They have been dry for long periods of time during the day and even after nap (big sign to start!)
- Should be fully accident free in pull-ups or undies for at least a few days (prefer a week) before we fully do undies and/or pull-ups here
- I will ask throughout the day if they have to potty, and usually make them go when it is "diaper change time"
- Potty training should mainly be done at home, but I am here to help support you here!
